<b>Re-opening for face to face services</b>	<p>It was agreed that the church would re-open for face to face services over the Holy Week and Easter period. Childrens groups however will not be able to re-commence until after Easter.</p> <p>The following service types and times were agreed</p> <p>Maundy Thursday – communion services at 10.30am, 2.30pm and 6.30pm (to tie in with a youth group being held at that time). If there is sufficient demand a further service could be added at 8pm</p> <p>Good Friday - will be at 10.30 am lead by Steve Murray and will be an all age service online and in person. There will be further, reflective service in person at 2pm lead by Marc</p> <p>Easter Day – will be all age services at 10.30 am and 12pm lead by Marc and will be online, on Zoom and in person. The 10.30 am service will have a time for communion. The 12pm service will not be streamed online.
