

Minutes of All Hallows Leadership Team Meeting at 7pm on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018

### **1 The minutes of the previous meeting were approved**

### **2 Matters Arising:**

**Building redevelopment-** The meeting of 16<sup>th</sup> July had been postponed and new date is yet to be fixed.

**Rota for inviting people to Sunday lunch:** Fenella will work on this during the Summer.

**Parenting Course update:** Heather has agreed with Stay & Play members to start in November and focus on 3-5 years. Kathryn Walker, Debs Stanhope and Emma Batten have shown an interest in helping and we have provisionally agreed to start in November.

Heather will discuss choose a suitable evening and if agreed an invitation will be printed, inviting others from S&P to join.

### **3 Focus on Families/Timing of service.**

Marc led a presentation of a structure plan for Kea, following a discussion with Jonathan Rowe: a brief summary follows:

Kea Church would have an Oversight Minister (current vicar), while each congregation would have a Focus Minister, leading a support team for pastoral care, discipleship, evangelism and relationships with newcomers). Currently Natalie Gavan holds this role for CAP, and Malcolm Henderson for Old Kea. At present Marc supports All Hallows and Truro.

As several group members were not present, it was decided to revisit the model at the next meeting.

Feedback from the Truro leadership team was that they wanted to keep the service time of 9.30am. The group felt there was a need to communicate the facts to the AH congregation, and also that we were still seeking an answer.

### **4 Evangelism-Talking Jesus**

Fenella showed some clips of the DVDs and booklet which make up the six week programme.

It was decided to offer the material for Small groups in the Autumn. Fenella will order 2 copies for circulation among Small Group Leaders and Liz will contact the 'pop-up' group leaders to check for interest.
