

ENABLE Into Action Group Activities Week Beginning 3rd December



group Activities

This week we come to the last group session before our Christmas Break. The whole of ENABLE is about understanding the gifts which God gives us to ENABLE us to live for him. In the first half of the term, we thought about the church and how we can help one another grow as disciples. In the second half of the term, we have been thinking about the gift of prayer, essential for us to grow as disciples. Now, we want to put some of our learning into practice. **As a group chose from one of the three options below:**

The Church

As a group devise an activity that brings you together as a small community to encourage one another as disciples. How might you be able to speak the truth in love together and encourage one another?

You might want to arrange a drinks evening where you share stories of things that God has done for you in 2023 and be encouraged. If you are a newer group, you might want to spend an evening getting to know one another better, maybe sharing how you each came to trust in Jesus. Alternatively, you might want to gather for some food and a questions evening. An evening where people ask questions that maybe they don't usually get a chance to ask and together you look at God's word to see how God might address each of the concerns raised. Another way to encourage each other would be to gather to reflect on 2023 and see how you might like to grow as a disciple in 2024.

There are lots of different ways you might gather, but the key is to spend time speaking truths of the gospel to one another to encourage each other.

Prayer

As a group devise a way to come together for an extended time of prayer. How might you help one another to put into practice some of the things we have been learning about prayer over the last few weeks?

This might be an evening where you have some simple food, have more time than usual to share prayer requests for each other and pray. It might be a commitment to hold a 12hrs of prayer as a group, each member praying for others in the group for an hour over the 12 hours. Alternatively, you might meet for a meal, each course of the meal focusing on a different country of the world, learning a little about the gospel need in that county and praying for that country as a group.

There are lots of different ways you can encourage one another to pray, what ever you do, the key is to spend time together praying.

Outreach

Finally, Christmas can be a great time to reach out to friends and family with the truth of the gospel. This group activity involves organising an activity or event as a small group to invite friends along to.

It might be that you gather with friends for drinks before or after one of our church Christmas services and invite them along to the service as well. It might be you host a Christmas party for your non-church friends to get to know your church friends better. It might be you decide to hold a Christmas meal and invite someone to come along and give a short four minute talk about Jesus after the meal, hosting a discussion. It might be you arrange a Christmas walk with non-Christian friends ending up at a pub, giving your friends a chance to chat to your church friends as you walk.

Whatever you do, pray that God would bless the activities you organise.

At this session we will introduce the third part of ENABLE where our focus will be on the person and work of the Holy Spirit.
