Discussions about tech and services and whether, for Truro's identity for its church family, we could have some sort of Zoom interaction in our services on our return to face-to-face. Vision for the future is not screen. Logistics is a key issue in considering tech communication from Kea Truro.

We talked about the BMO and noted that all the churches involved have accepted it.

Marc made the point, through Will, that bigger and much stronger churches than ours are in crisis. Reminder of all God's blessings to us!
